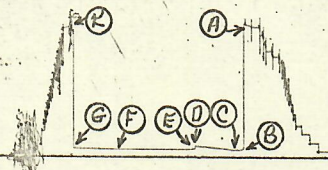
DID WELL FLOW - Gas No Oil No Water No
