### INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

A partially buried produced water vessel (PWV) was removed from the Triple L Farms #1 location on March 28, 2018. Groundwater and impacted soil were not encountered in the PWV excavation. A liner was not present beneath the PWV at this site. The PWV at this facility has been permanently removed. Soil samples from the excavation were submitted for laboratory analysis, to determine if a release occurred. The general site layout, soil sample location, and PWV excavation dimensions are depicted on the Sample Location Map provided as Figure 1.

### PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

#### Proposed Soil Sampling

On March 28, 2018, following removal of the PWV, soil samples were collected from the sidewalls and base of the excavation. The soil samples were field-screened for volatile organic compounds using a photoionization detector (PID). Soil sample B01@6' was submitted for laboratory analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX), total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) – gasoline range organics (GRO) by EPA Method 8260C, TPH diesel and oil range organics (DRO and ORO) by EPA Method 8015, pH, and electrical conductivity (EC). Laboratory analytical results for soil sample B01@6' indicate that BTEX, TPH, pH, and EC concentrations and levels were in full compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 allowable levels. The soil sample analytical results are summarized in Table 1, and the laboratory analytical report is attached.

Laboratory results indicate that soil sample B01 @6' was in full compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 allowable levels, therefore, no soils were removed. The excavation area was backfilled and contoured to match pre-existing site conditions.

Laboratory results indicate that soil sample concentrations were in compliance with COGCC allowable levels. Groundwater was not encountered in the PWV excavation. Based on the analytical data presented herein, assessment is complete at this site and no further activities are required. Upon COGCC approval of the Initial Form 27, Kerr-McGee will submit a Supplemental Form 27 request for a No Further Action (NFA) determination for this site.
