 Field Inspector Actions:
 On 05-13-2019, I was contacted by COGCC staff about a complaint received by the COGCC in reference to Odor. The complainant stated the issues were occurring outside of his home, from the Interchange A&B pad.
 On 05-14-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complaint who stated on his complaint that on 5-12-19 at approximately 9:10 in the morning there was a continuous smell of motor oil until the wind shifted. The motor oil could be smelled when there was a slight breeze from the east. I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. At time of inspection, I talked with Extraction drilling supervisor he stated at time of complaint they were drilling and no unusual activity was taking place. We also spoke about adjusting odorant being used in drill cuttings. At time of inspection, I did not smell any unusual odors. I spoke with Broomfield inspectors and they are aware of complaint and have responded to it.
