On 05-14-2019, I was contacted by COGCC staff about a complaint received by the COGCC in reference to Odor. The complainant stated the issues were occurring outside of her home, from the Interchange A&B pad.

On 05-14-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complaint who indicated that on 5-13-19 at approximately 9:45PM complainant experienced an overwhelming odor of oil. It was so strong that she had to close all of our windows in the house. Odor dissipated within the next 40 min. I informed her on 5-13-19 at approximately 10:30PM; I arrived at complainant's neighborhood and smelled a strong odor. I did follow the odor back to the Interchange B drilling pad. I informed the complainant that my findings would be in my full inspection report filled with the COGCC.
