Field Inspector Actions:

On 05-17-2019, I was contacted by COGCC staff about a complaint received by the COGCC in reference to Odor. The complainant stated the issues were occurring outside of her home, from the Interchange A&B pad.

On 05-17-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complaint who indicated on her complaint form that on 5-16-19 at approximately 7:45 she smelled two odors between 160th and 156th while driving south on Huron. The first odor smelled pleasant and was like a detergent. The second odor smelled like crude oil. At time of inspection on 05-17-19 at approximately 6:40PM, I did not smell any unusual odors. I drove around complainant's neighborhood and Interchange B drilling pad where I performed a site inspection of the drilling operations. At time of inspection, it was raining and there was a drop in temperature. I spoke with Broomfield inspectors and they are aware of complaint. See inspection document #688402196 per my inspection.
