After drilling firm cement from 4867 to 4933 with 7" casing cemented at 4936 perforations were placed in the casing opposite the oil bearing sand. On March 14, 1951, Lane Wells shot 96 holes evenly spaced from 4913 to 4929 with 15/32" steel bullets. Swabbing then began through tubing. After 52 bbls. of oil with some rotary mud was swabbed from the tubing, the well began to flow. From 5:00 PM March 16, 1951, to 8:00 AM March 17, 1951, the well flowed 793 bbls. clean oil for a calculated open flow IP of 1269 bbls. per day.

The elevation above sea level is 4237.25 ft. K.B. & 4227.9 ground.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

On March 10 and 11, 1951, 7" casing was run and cemented at 4936 from Kelly Bushings with 200 sacks regular cement, 2% Gel. mixture. The total depth of the hole being 4938' from Kelly Bushings. The description of the production casing is as follows: 23 joints, 23#, J-55, 8R thread, 720.20 feet on bottom, then 98 joints, 4198.17 feet, 20#, J-55, 8R, Range 3, landed with 1 joint, 27.16 feet, 23#, J-55, 8R thread. There were 2 centralizers placed at 4933', and 4910, with wall scratchers from 4931 to 4912. The cement top in the annulas was found to be at approximately 3625' from Kelly Bushings with temperature survey. The cement was allowed to set 52-3/4 hours, at which time, 500 psi. pump pressure was applied after having drilled midway between the shoe and first casing collar. There was no leakage found so work was continued.
