

Project Summary

Site Name: Beren's Former Simpson "A" Production Pit

Document No.: 1126696

Site History:

Fritzler Resources, Inc. did not operate the Beren's Former Simpson "A" production pit which had been closed prior to Fritzler's acquisition of the Simpson lease. The Commission issued to Beren Corporation on November 1, 2002 a Notice of Violation regarding the historic production pit. Fritzler voluntarily agreed to remediate the historic production pit. See March 4, 2004 correspondence to the Commission.

Work Completed:

A Form 27 was submitted in April 2004 and approved by the Commission.

Fritzler promptly removed all the piping and debris.

The Commission approved a sampling grid to test for soil impacts and the sampling and analysis report was submitted to the Commission in August 2004. The Commission approved re-seeding of the area and subsequent reviews to evaluate the re-vegetation.

As part of the remediation, Fritzler ripped and disked the area and seeded the area in the fall of 2004. Additional seeding was completed in May 2007, April 2010 and November 2014.

The upper sections have been successfully stabilized and re-vegetated.

Swales have been built and waddles added to stabilize the lower area.

Remaining Work:

The remaining work for the lower area includes:

1. Re-disking, harrowing;
2. Reseeding; and
3. Crimping and mulching

The remaining area that needs to be re-vegetated is less than a 1/2 acre. Fritzler anticipates completing this work in 2019. It is possible the area may need to be re-seeded in subsequent years.

Estimated Cost to Complete the Remaining Work:

1.	Re disking, harrowing	\$ 2700.00
2.	Reseeding	\$ 600.00
3.	Crimping and mulching	\$ 1200.00
4.	Second Reseeding Application (if necessary)	\$ 1500.00
