 On 06-03-2019, I Field Inspector, Randy Silver was issued a complaint received by COGCC staff in reference to Odor. The complainant Kathy Swan-Bogard 15543 Quivas st Broomfield CO stated the issues were occurring outside of her home.
 On 06-03-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complainant via phone on 6-03-19 at approx... 9:40AM. She stated, smelling oil/petroleum products. That caused a lot of eye irritation and very sore throat.
 I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. At time of inspection, I did not smell any unusual odors. I informed her I was on the street where she lives, at 9:15AM speaking to another complainant about odor. At time of conversation with other complainant, we did not smell any unusual odors. I spoke with Broomfield inspectors and they are aware of complaint and have responded to it.
 At time of inspection, I spoke with Extraction drilling supervisor he stated at approx... time of complaint they were performing normal drilling operations, no unusual activity was taking place.
