Dear Mr. Brueske,

On April 2, 2019 the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) received your complaint regarding excavation being done by Crestone Peak Resources at Rangier Farms (identified in the COGCC database as the Ross F Unit Tank Battery); specifically your question as to whether or not Crestone had approval to do the work you observed. You also expressed concern regarding ground water. The results of the COGCC investigation in response to your complaint can be found by clicking on the "Complaints" link on the COGCC website (<http://www.cogcc.state.co.us/complaints.html>) and searching under COGCC complaint document number 200447097.

FIELD INSPECTION

The COGCC performed an inspection of the subject location on April 6, 2019. The findings of that inspection are listed in COGCC Field Inspection Form Document No. 688500140, a copy of which is attached. At the time of the inspection, the subject tank battery and associated flowlines had been removed and impacts to soil from a historical release had been discovered.

FORM 19 SPILL/RELEASE REPORT

The operator submitted a Form 19 Spill/Release Report (Document No. 401988917, Spill/Release Point 463743) notifying the COGCC of their discovery of the historical release. The operator also used their Form 19 to request a determination of no further action required on their part. That request was denied and as a Condition of Approval, the COGCC required that the operator submit a Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Work Plan.


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FORM 27 SITE INVESTIGATION AND REEDIATION WORK PLAN
