I wanted to touch base with you in hopes to get an update on our permits for our storage well

replacement project in the Wolf Creek storage field. As of today we have received approvals from the Forrest Service, BLM, and as you see below, from Pitkin County. I have attached our form 2A as well as the Finding of No Significant Impact from Pitkin County for your reference. This project is to replace two existing storage wells that are critical in meeting peak demand during the heating season for our customers from Carbondale to Aspen, and it is critical to place these wells in service to meet that demand this winter.
