 On 06-24-2019, I Randy Silver area field inspector was assigned a complaint received by COGCC staff in reference to noise. The complainant Brittney White 13608 Weld County, Fort Lupton CO stated the issues were occurring outside of complainants home.  
 On 06-25-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complainant who indicated that on 6-21-19 complainant experienced a high-pitched sequel from KPK PU when running. She stated they were a crappy company that does not maintain or check there equipment. She stated this issue has been going on for a few weeks. It is difficult at times to have a conversation outside without disruption. Her parents sleep with their windows open and the squeals are constantly waking them up.  
 I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. I spoke with Complainant Brittney White on location where she stated she has attempted to get in contact with KPK about the noise and several other issues on her property but has had no response from them.  
 At time of inspection, I did observe and record PU while in operation and it appeared to be making high-pitched sound from the saddle bearing. I observed other Corrective actions while performing my inspection.
