 Field Inspector Actions:  
 On 07-15-2019, I Randy Silver area field inspector was assigned a complaint received by COGCC staff in reference to Dust. The complainant Becky Mcleod 15844 Wild Horse Dr Broomfield stated the issues were occurring at Livingston pad.  
 On 07-15-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complainant who indicated that on 7-12-19 observed a photo of what appeared to be a large cloud of dust she saw on the Nextdoor community forum. When I spoke with complaint, I explained, complaints need to be firsthand information to be able to do a viable complaint.  
 I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. At time of inspection, I did not observe and plume on location.  
 At time of inspection, I spoke with Manny Parras drilling supervisor, he stated at time of complaint they were drilling and were unloading several cement trucks. I spoke with supervisor about proper unloading procedures. Supervisor stated he talked to cement truck operators and would correct the issue.
