While there, I observed a temporarily abandoned wellhead. During this inspection the following possible compliance issues were observed: 1. Unused equipment inside of fencing that contains wellhead. COMPLY WITH RULE 603.F. (Corrective Action Date: August 15, 2019) See attached photo #1. 2. Stained soil at wellhead. SECURELY FASTEN ALL VALVES, PIPES, AND FITTINGS TO ENSURE MECHANICAL CONDITION, INSPECT AT REGULAR INTERVALS AND MAINTAIN IN GOOD MECHANICAL CONDITION PER RULE 605.D. (Corrective Action Date: August 15, 2019) See attached photo #2.
