RE: Response to COGCC NOVA No. 401957001

Dear Mr. Mah:

This letter is in response to our phone conversation on July 2, 2019 concerning the NOVA number 401957001.

Pursuant to rule 319.b The Hill Ranch 25-12V API No. 05-071-07280-00 was not temporarily abandoned. With no TA in effect there should not be any need for a mechanical integrity test to be conducted.

On December 17 & 18 a workover rig was on this location to complete a pump change on the well. Upon pulling the tubing out of the casing, the tubing became stuck. The stuck tubing was left in the casing and the well continued to flow gas in a normal operation. The only effect of the stuck tubing on the well was the inability to remove water from the well bore. Timber Creek has submitted the required monthly volume reports showing the flowing of gas for this location from Dec 2018 to current month.

On February 22, 2019 a COGCC staff member did conduct an inspection of the Hill Ranch 25-12V. The field inspection report No. 695100244 was received on February 28, 2019. There was a leak found releasing gas at the tubing to casing rubber on the well head. On February 28, 2019 the leak was repaired, and a follow up inspection was conducted by staff of the COGCC and field inspection report No. 695100262 was submitted stating the leak was repaired. Records of the last workover were requested on the follow up inspection and were sent on March 5, 2019 on field inspection report resolution No. 401961388.

On March 5, 2019 Timber Creek Operations and Engineering Managers contacted the COGCC engineer regarding the NOVA No. 401957001 by phone conversation. After explaining to the engineer that the well in question was never in temporary abandon status it was determined no further action was needed. Timber Creek has continued to operate the well and report the volumes as required.
