Additionally, SS-03@3' was analyzed for EC by Modified 9050A, SAR by 20B Saturated Paste, and pH by EPA 9045D.

Excavation of impacted soil will be conducted. Eagle Environmental will be on location to field guide the excavation and grab soil samples above the phreatic zone for analysis of TPH-DRO, TPH-GRO, BTEX, and Naphthalene. If groundwater infiltrates the base of the excavation Eagle Environmental will collect a sample for analysis of BTEX. Soil samples will be collected from 0-3' below ground surface and analyzed for SAR from the outer extent of the excavation sidewalls to ensure compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 standards.
