On behalf of the Garfield County Board of County Commissioners, the Garfield County Landfill authorizes the disposal of, **1 yd. of Hydrocarbon Impacted Soil.** Point of origin is CPX-TPR Assets (25A/CFF/36A), Spruce Creek area. Garfield County Landfill has reviewed your waste characterization information dated 7-30-2019 and has recommended disposal of the waste at our facility.

The hydrocarbon impacted soil will be placed in Cell 6. An experienced and trained landfill technician will visually monitor off-loading of the waste at the landfill. Note that Garfield County reserves the right to deny disposal of the waste at the landfill gate. This facility will not accept material characterized as a hazardous waste or liquids and other fluid waste that fail the paint filter test. The county also reserves the right to sample and test the material upon its arrival as quality control for the characterization information you provided at no delay to you. If analytical results indicate a waste other than initially characterized, criminal charges may apply.

Please contact me if you should have any questions about the disposal of this waste, landfill operations or policies, or general handling of waste materials.
