



Plan of Development

The existing RWF 21-18 Pad will be re-constructed to support drill cuttings disposal for 20 proposed wells on the PA 44-13 Pad. Drilling cuttings will be hauled by truck from the PA 44-13 pad to the drilling pit on the RWF 21-18 pad. Estimate cuttings volume from the 20 proposed wells is approximately 7,000cy. New disturbance of approximately 0.17ac will occur along the south-east side of the pad to improve the long-term reclamation potential of the cut slope. Excess excavated material from the pit will be staged along the access road south of the pad. Topsoil will be striped and temporarily stage east of the drilling pit.
