 Field Inspector Actions:  
 On 08-27-2019, I Randy Silver area field inspector was assigned a complaint received by COGCC staff in reference to Fencing and sign issues. The complainant Julie Hladky 13608 WRC 18 ½ Fort Lupton CO stated the issues were occurring at a KPK well next to her home.  
 On 08-27-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complainant who indicated that on 8-26-19 KPK employees drove onto her property to access well. The main gate to access well was drug through the dirt and damaged. Gate was left open and her horses got out and were found in hayfield. Also, stated she was unable to locate emergence contact number on sign to notify KPK.  
 I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. At time of inspection, I observed KPK had installed small sign wired to bottom of old operator sign with operator name and contact number. I did observe and write up several corrective actions See FIR inspection documents for full inspections.  
 At time of inspection, I spoke with (Company) drilling supervisor he stated at time of complaint they were drilling and no unusual activity was taking place.  
 Weather conditions: Clear and location dry.
