 On 09-08-2019, I Randy Silver area field inspector was assigned a complaint received by COGCC staff in reference to Odor. The complainant Cindie Scoby 15849 Longview DR Broomfield CO stated the issues were occurring outside of complainants home.
 On 09-09-2019, I attempted to make contact with the complainant who indicated that on 9-07-19 she experienced a sweet odor while having coffee on her deck at 8:00AM. She has an open area behind her house and have a direct shot to the gas fracking wells. I performed a complete site inspection of the oil and gas location and associated wells in the area. At time of inspection, I did not smell any unusual odors at the Livingston drilling pad.
 At time of inspection, I spoke with Manny Parras drilling supervisor he stated at time of complaint they were drilling and no unusual activity was taking place.
