- 5-26-54 DST #1 (4902-11') Open 1 hour, strong blow with gas to surface in 7 minutes at 180 MGF per day. Oil to surface in 1 hour, recovered 4840' of 38° gravity oil, 30' of water.
- 5-27-54 DST #2 (5014-27') Open 1 hour, fair blow throughout test, recovered 10' slightly oil cut mud. Ran Schlumberger.
- 5-28-54 Cemented 5 1/2" at 5015' with 100 sacks plus 4% gel.
- 6-9-54 Bottom hole survey, Datum 4866', 1031 psi Bottom hole pressure-174 °F Bottom hole temperature.
- 7-6-54 Pumped 95 barrels of oil, no water, in 24 hours thru Muddy perforations 4900-12'.
