Dear Director Robbins,

I want to express my support for the flaring and field operations proposed for the Petroleum Resource Management Corp (PRM) well pad containing the WPU-36-1V-H2 well (API# 05-081-07799-02). I am the ranch owner located approximately 1400 feet to the southeast of the well pad. The ranch buildings are only seasonally occupied during the summer months for cattle grazing and hay growing operations. The ranch buildings consist of a house, several barns and smaller out buildings. In addition to being the ranch owner I am also the surface and mineral rights owner for the well pad.

The flare at this location has been safely and efficiently operated several times over the last few years to support drilling and production operations of the vertical well (WPU-36-1V, #05-081-07799-00) and a horizontal well (WPU-36-1V-H1, #05-081-07799-01). There have not been any issues with the operation. Light pollution, odors, noise, and emissions are not a concern.

PRM runs a clean and efficient operation and they have been an excellent operator addressing our needs and any concerns that might arise. I have been on the well pad many times during past flaring operations. I have not noticed any odors and I have not had any concerns about the health and safety aspects of the operation.
