NOTICE OF PROPOSED DESIGNATION OF THE  
"J" SAND AS AN EXEMPT AQUIFER

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Enstar Petroleum, Inc. filed an application for approval to dispose of water produced from the "O" Sand of the Iliff-Ertle 18-1 well in the Hamil Ranch Field into the "J" Sand in the No. 18-1 Hamil Brothers, located 1800 feet from the north line and 2040 feet from the east line of Section 18, Township 9 North, Range 52 West, 6th P.M., Logan County, Colorado.

The "J" Sand is found at a depth of 4670 feet to 4725 feet in said well. The casing was perforated from 4684 feet to 4688 feet. Analysis shows the "O" Sand water to contain 4235 milligrams per liter total dissolved solids and the "J" Sand water 9090 milligrams per liter total dissolved solids.

Based on the data supplied by Enstar Petroleum, Inc., the "J" Sand would qualify as an exempt aquifer under this Commission's Rule No. 326 (d).

Any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by the designation may request the Commission to hold a hearing thereon.


If, within 30-days after publication of this notice, the Commission does not receive a hearing request which indicates there is a significant degree of public interest in a hearing on the designation of the aquifer, the "J" Sand in the Hamil Brothers well shall be considered exempt.

If a significant degree of public interest in a hearing is shown, the Commission shall hold such a hearing as soon as practicable and shall make a final determination regarding the designation.
