Alex,

I wanted to reiterate some of the points of today's discussion:

- Laramie is in communication with the landowner (Chevron) concerning the impacts from the spill. The preliminary water and soil analysis indicate the levels of BTEX and TPH constituents are below table 910-1.
- The landowner has indicated they would prefer little or no disturbance to the surface in the area(s) of the release.
- Arsenic, SAR, EC, and PH levels appear to be high (as is typically characteristic of produced water). Laramie is conducting additional background soil samples to assess the wide range of alkalinity levels that are naturally occurring in proximity to the release.
- If Laramie can demonstrate the only Table 910-1 criteria of concern are Arsenic, SAR, EC, and PH, we will propose a plan that would preclude digging of the surface and rely upon monitoring of the existing vegetation (for impacts) for 1 year.
- Laramie is in the process of augmenting sediment control BMPs along the drainage flows in the area of the release to prevent any residual contamination from entering the irrigation channel.
