9/11/2019: Mobilize P&A equipment to location, spot in base beam, shut down due to inclement weather

9/12/2019: MIRU workover rig, lay lines, NDWH, NUBOP, RU rig floor, TOH 2-3/8" 4.7# tubing
PU 7" 23# bit and casing scraper, TIH to 175', TOH, LD BHA
PU 7" 23# CIBP, TIH and set CIBP at 157', circulate well clean
Pressure tested casing to 500 psi per BLM orders, held for 30 minutes
Pumped 43.6 sxs of 15.8# class G neat 1.15 cu.ft./sack yield cement on top of CIBP to surface
TOH and LD tubing, topped off well with 5 sxs of cement, RD work floor, NDBOP
RD rig, shut down for night

9/13/2019: Dig out and cut off wellhead 6' below ground level
Verified that cement was at surface in both casing and annulus
Welded cap and info plate onto casing, documented with pictures
Backfill pit, prepare for rig move, clean location, shut down for night, P&A complete
