Dear Mr. Fischer:

This letter is follow-up to confirm the information provided to the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) during an October 2, 2019 phone call between CPX Piceance and COGCC regarding an unused tank battery referenced as part of the July 9, 2019 inspection Doc [#698100038] Page 4 and as part of the closure of Teepee Park CFF (Facility ID #416339).

The tanks in question were installed in 2012 according to CPX records and aerial photography. COGCC inspection 670200906 conducted by Craig Burger on 9/26/2013 notes the presence of the two 300 bbl tanks and that they are empty and not in use. CPX personnel, Bryan Clark, involved in the project since 2002 attest that the tanks were never put into service, nor were they ever plumbed to accept any fluids. The tanks were removed from the site in July 2018 as part of the closure of Teepee Park CFF (Facility ID #416339).
