The well is located 2310 ft. ~~(N)~~ of North line and 2310 ft. ~~(E)~~ of East line.

The elevation above sea level is 4163 ft. Ground; 4173 Kelly-Bushing.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

The well was plugged and abandoned in the base of the "J" sand of the Dakota Series at a total depth of approximately 4170 feet. A cement plug was pumped in the well from 4170 ft to 3975 ft thereby sealing off all sands of the Dakota Series in which any fluid was present. Heavy mud was pumped into the well from 3975 ft. to base of surface pipe at 340 ft. A 30-ft. cement plug was placed in the well from 340 to 310 ft; heavy mud from 310 ft. to 20 ft. and cement plug from 20 ft. to surface.

As this well is located in a cultivated field, no pipe was set above ground to permanently mark the location.
