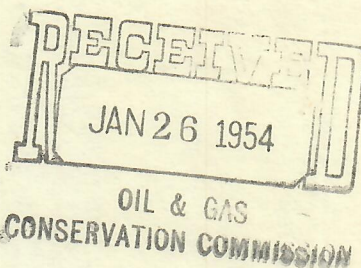

There were 147 joints of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " O D, 15.5#, J-55, new casing
 run and cemented with 100 sacks of regular cement at 4570 feet from
 kelly bushings. The temperature survey taken approximately 20 hours
 after the cement was in place found the cement top behind the casing
 at 4198 feet.

There were 4 Lane-Wells cone shots per foot and 2 Lane-
 Wells steel bullets per foot placed in the casing from 4483 feet to
 4490 feet Schlumberger electric log measurements. The open flow
 gauge was 3,880,000 cubic feet of gas per day through 2 inch tubing.
