## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

A partially buried produced water vessel (PWV) was removed from the Heisman V 28-13 location on October 24, 2019. Groundwater and impacted soil were not encountered in the PWV excavation. A liner was not present beneath the PWV at this site. The PWV at this facility has been permanently removed. Soil samples from the excavation were submitted for laboratory analysis, to determine if a release occurred. The general site layout, soil sample locations, and PWV excavation dimensions are depicted on the Facility Layout & Sample Locations Map provided as Figure 1.

## PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

### Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? ( Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples ):

On October 24, 2019, following removal of the PWV, soil samples were collected from the sidewalls and base of the excavation. The soil samples were field-screened for volatile organic compounds using a photoionization detector (PID). Soil samples B01E@6', N01E@5', W01E@5', S01E@5', and E01E@5' were submitted for laboratory analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX), total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), and naphthalene. The base soil sample was also analyzed for pH, specific conductance (EC), and sodium adsorption ratio (SAR). Laboratory analytical results for all soil samples indicate that BTEX, TPH, pH, EC, and SAR concentrations and levels were in full compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 allowable levels. The soil sample analytical results are summarized in Table 1, and the laboratory analytical report is attached.

Laboratory results indicate that all soil samples were in full compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 allowable levels; therefore, no soils were removed. The excavation area was backfilled and contoured to match pre-existing site conditions.
