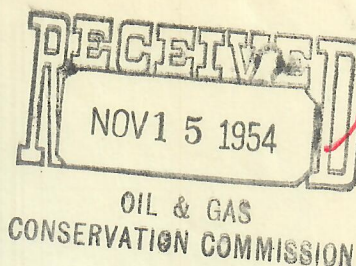

After drilling to a total depth of 5123' and finding no productive sand we
 have received proper authority from State Commission to plug and abandon.
 Well plugged and abandoned according to Colorado State regulations as follows;

Spotted a cement plug in bottom of hole from 5123' to 4896'. Filled hole with
 drilling mud to bottom of surface casing (132') and spotted a cement plug from
 132' to 100' and a 20' cement plug in top of surface casing which is below ground
 level and will not interfere with soil cultivation.
 All cement spotted thru 4-1/2" full hole drill pipe.
