## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

A partially-buried produced water vessel (PWV) was removed from the Streed 15-13A facility on October 1, 2019. Impacted soil was not encountered in the PWV excavation. A liner was present beneath the PWV at this site. Groundwater was encountered in the excavation at approximately 3 feet below ground surface (bgs). The PWV at this facility has been permanently removed. Soil and groundwater samples from the excavation were submitted for laboratory analysis to determine if a release occurred. A topographic Site Location Map showing the geographic setting of the site location is provided as Figure 1. Soil and groundwater sample locations are illustrated on Figure 2.

## PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

### Proposed Soil Sampling

On October 1, 2019, five (5) confirmation soil samples were collected from the sidewalls and base of the final extent of the excavation area at depths of approximately 3 feet and 4 feet below ground surface (bgs), respectively. The base soil sample was submitted for laboratory analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, total xylenes (BTEX), naphthalene, and total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) - gasoline range organics (GRO) by United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Method 8260D, TPH - diesel range organics (DRO) and oil range organics (ORO) by USEPA Method 8015D, pH by USEPA Method 9045D, specific conductance (EC) by USEPA Method 9050A, and sodium adsorption ratio (SAR) by USDA Agricultural Handbook 60 Method 20B. The sidewall soil samples were submitted for laboratory analysis of BTEX, naphthalene, and TPH. Laboratory analytical results indicate

### Proposed Groundwater Sampling

Groundwater was encountered in the excavation at approximately three (3) feet below ground surface (bgs). One (1) groundwater sample (GW01) was collected and submitted to Origins Laboratory for analysis of BTEX by USEPA Method 8260D. Analytical results indicated that constituent concentrations in groundwater sample GW01 were in full compliance with COGCC standards.

Laboratory results indicate that constituent concentrations in the soil samples collected from the final extent of the excavation area were in full compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 allowable levels; therefore, no soils were removed. The excavation area was backfilled and contoured to match pre-existing site conditions.

## REMEDIATION SUMMARY

Describe how remediation of existing impacts to soil and groundwater is to be accomplished (i.e. summarize remedial action plan). Laboratory results indicate that constituent concentrations in the 5 soil samples collected from the final extent of the excavation area were in full compliance with COGCC standards. Groundwater was encountered in the excavation at approximately 3 feet bgs. Laboratory analytical results indicate that constituent concentrations in groundwater sample GW01 were in full compliance with COGCC standards. Based on the analytical data presented herein, assessment is complete at this site and no further activities are required. As such, Kerr-McGee is requesting a No Further Action (NFA) determination for location.
