Date of meeting: Thursday, August 23, 2018

Time of meeting: 5:30 P.M.

Location of meeting: County Line 3130 Pad Location -

Attendees: Pam McCue, John McCue and Verdad Landman Jeff Berghorn.

Meeting was regarding the County Line 3130 Location

- Truck traffic – Truck traffic for County Line will come from North or South on Interstate 76 and head East Down 168th/WCR 2. Verdad agreed no access will come from the North end of parcel as not to disturb the Fox Haven Estates Community. Verdad will mitigate dust as needed.
- Water Well Testing – Verdad will follow all COGCC and State of Colorado requirements to perform baseline and post production water testing of individual water wells.
- Noise Mitigation – Verdad will comply with State of Colorado and Weld County guidelines. Verdad agreed to construct a sound wall between the County Line location and the Fox Haven Estates Community to the North of the proposed location for the duration of drilling and completion operations.
- Light Mitigation – Verdad agreed to direct lights into location so that light may be reasonably contained by sound wall.

Date of meeting: Wednesday, October 24, 2018

Time of meeting: 10:00 A.M.

Location of meeting: County Line 3130/3107/3112 Pad Location -

Attendees: COGCC 2A Representatives, Colorado Parks and Wildlife Representative, Verdad Representatives.

An on-site was conducted in accordance with COGCC and CPW to investigate the validity of a noted eagle nest 1000' to the South of the proposed County Line location. It was decided by CPW that this nest is no longer active and is an auxiliary location for the eagles to land at for a short period of time. CPW advised Verdad and the COGCC that this location should not be included in the eagle buffer zone. Verdad agreed to monitor the area during operations and self-report if the auxiliary area were to become active again during operations on the County Line pad.

Time of meeting: 6:00 P.M.

Location of meeting: Afterglow Senior Center- Lochbuie, Colorado

Attendees: Fox Haven Community Members, Arbor Valley Nursery Employee, Jason Maxey-Weld County LGD, Verdad EH&S, Operations, Regulatory and Land personnel

Meeting was regarding the County Line 3130-County Line 3112 and County Line 3107 Location

- Truck traffic – Truck traffic for County Line will come from North or South on Interstate 76 and head East Down 168th/WCR 2. Verdad agreed no access will come from the North end of parcel as not to disturb the Fox Haven Estates Community. Verdad will mitigate dust as needed.
- Water Well Testing – Verdad will follow all COGCC and State of Colorado requirements to perform baseline and post production water testing of individual water wells. Verdad also agreed to install a groundwater monitoring well on the well pad that will be sampled periodically for the life of the location.
- Noise Mitigation – Verdad will comply with State of Colorado and Weld County guidelines. Verdad agreed to construct a sound wall between the County Line location and the Fox Haven Estates Community to the North of the proposed location for the duration of drilling and completion operations. Verdad also agreed to use “quiet” frac fleets.
- Light Mitigation – Verdad agreed to direct lights into location so that light may be reasonably contained by sound wall.
- Pad Location – Verdad Agreed to move the County Line 3130 location further to the South on the designated parcel and combine it with the County Line 3112/3107 pad in order to create a greater distance from edge of disturbance to the Fox Haven Community.
