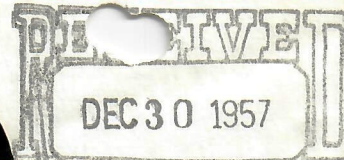

Pursuant to my recent telephone conversation with Mr. Bill Smith of your office concerning our #1 and #2 Morton wells in Sec. 19, T6N, R86W, Routt County, Colorado. This will inform you that the #1 Morton has reached a total depth of 3,370'. It is our intention to plug back and complete this well as an oil producer from zones at 850-900' and 2,775-80'. As soon as completion work is finished, we will forward the appropriate completion report and plugging record to your office. Commencement of the #2 Morton has been postponed, probably until mid 1958.
