Engineering Integrity Field Inspection performed on December 16th, 2019 in response to initial form 19 spill report Doc #402260584 received by COGCC on 12/13/2019 that outlines: During dump line removal activities associated with the Camp 13-19A facility, historical petroleum hydrocarbon impacts to the subsurface were encountered. The volume of the release is unknown.

<u>Comment:</u>	COGCC Inspector met with Anadarko contract personnel (NG Services) on location. The Camp 13-19A facility/ battery is being decommissioned/ equipment removed; the dump flowlines and process pipe associated with the old battery are being removed. Contractors uncovered several historically abandoned dump lines and are in the process of removing these flowlines. The original Camp 13-19A on location wellhead flowline was also removed; a new on location flowline has been constructed and routed north to a shared facility/ battery. This flowline was pressure tested (prior to being put into service). Contractors were completing excavation/ remediation work at the time of this field inspection.
