Reached total depth of 5246'KB, completed Logs and plugged hole as follows; Ran Drill Pipe open ended, spotted heavy mud from 5246' to 5081', 50 sax cement from 5081' to 4921', heavy mud from 4921' to 214', 15 sax cement from 214' to 169', heavy mud from 169' to 40', 10 sax cement from 40' to surface. Erected marker in cement and abandoned location.
