Site History:

Voluntary reclamation of the Ben Gay pit was initiated in 2013. A fiberglass skim tank was installed.

The interim reclamation efforts have been completed. The following is a summary of the effort.

A Form 27 was submitted in July 2015 and approved by the Commission.

In October 2017, 1000 gallons of liquids were removed and disposed at CSI and approximately 99.06 tons of soils were removed and transported to a Waste Management facility.

Samples were taken in July of 2018. DRO, GRO, pH, and SAR values were below Table 910 standards. Sampling results were submitted to the Commission.

Samples of the area south of the pit were also taken. This area was disked and seeded in November 2018.

All structural items from the skim pit were removed in 2019.

The evaporation pit berms were re-built in 2019 and waddles were placed on the sides of the south water pit berms. The area was fenced. Since the area is within the tank boundaries, revegetation is not required at this time.

New Work Completed:

The Skim pit has been closed.

Perimeter trenches as additional BMP's were placed around the pits to complement the waddles.

Areas south of the pits have been, re-disked, harrowed, seeded with a combination of salt resistant grass species and prairie grasses, and mulched.

Remaining Work:

1. Continued to monitor the revegetation effort.
