Dear Director Robbins:

Confluence Resources (Confluence) respectfully requests that the Director grant an exception location to Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Rules 318A.a. or 318A.c. for the above referenced wells.

COGCC Rule 318.A.a. stipulates that a Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) well surface location must be within a 400' by 400' drilling window centered at the center of each quarter-quarter section, or inside an 800' by 800' drilling window centered at the center of each quarter section.

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Rule 318A.c. states that, "when an operator is requesting a surface well location greater than fifty feet (50') from a well, the operator shall provide a consent to the exception signed by the surface owner on which the well is proposed to be located in order for the Director to approve the well location administratively."

Confluence requests the Director approve the proposed exception location. The surface owner acknowledges and agrees with the staked surface location of the well. The signed Exception Location Waiver is attached.
