Dear Director:

The surface location of Noble Energy Inc. (Noble) proposed well(s) has been staked outside of the 318A.a drilling window, per surface owner request. The location is being permitted as an exception location. Noble has obtained written permission contained in a Surface Use Agreement from the surface owner.

Under the Revised Rule 318A.c any new twinning well is to be located within 50' of an existing well. The surface location of Noble's proposed well(s) has been staked greater than 50' from the nearest oil and gas well. Noble has obtained permission, contained in a Surface Use Agreement, from the surface owner, which is attached. Requirements 7, 8, and 9 within the COGCC Form 2 Attachment Guidance for Exception Location Requests are captured on page 5, section 6 of the Surface Use Agreement.

Thank you for your attention to the enclosed. Noble respectfully requests that the COGCC review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location waivers and Application for Permit to Drill the captioned well(s).
