OPERATOR COMMENTS AND SUBMITTAL

Comments

The purpose of this refile is to extend permit expiration. The proposed wellsite has not been built and the well is not in a buffer zone. No changes have been made to the surrounding land use, lease description, cultural distances or the well construction plan. Only the following information has been updated on this Form 2: Distance from the proposed wellbore to nearest existing or proposed wellbore belonging to another operator and referenced non-op well in comment below, Offset Well Evaluation and the Operator BMPs. No other changes have been made from the previously approved Form 2, the associated Form 2A will also be refilled.

The distance to the completed portion of the nearest well on the "Spacing & Formations" tab was measured to Extraction's Mead 10 well. The distance to the completed portion of the nearest well belonging to another operator on the "Drilling & Waste Plans" tab was measured to Enerplus Resource's Melville 7-66-3-10-4C. Both distances were measured in 2D via COGCC GIS Mapping.

Extraction respectfully requests an Exception to Rule 318A.a. The Mead pad is located outside a GWA window. Please see the waiver from the surface owner attached to the scout card.

This refile is being submitted prior to permit expiration, so no new 305 Surface Owner Notice, Exception Location Waiver, Exception Location Request Letter to the Director, or new PSU notifications are required.

1 Drilling/Completion Operations	Anti-collision: Operator will perform an anti-collision evaluation of all active (producing, shut in, or temporarily abandoned) offset wellbores that have the potential of being within 150 feet of a proposed well prior to drilling operations for the proposed well. Notice shall be given to all offset operators prior to drilling.
2 Drilling/Completion Operations	Operator acknowledges and will comply with COGCC policy for Bradenhead Monitoring during Hydraulic Fracturing treatments in the Greater Wattenberg Area dated May 29, 2012.
3 Drilling/Completion Operations	Alternative Logging Program: One of the first wells drilled on the pad will be logged with open-hole resistivity log and gamma-ray log from the kick-off point into the surface casing. All wells on the pad will have a cement bond log with gamma-ray run on production casing (or on intermediate casing if production liner is run) into the surface casing. The horizontal portion of every well will be logged with a measured-while-drilling gamma-ray log. The Form 5, Completion Report, for each well on the pad will list all logs run and have those logs attached. The Form 5 for a well without open-hole logs shall state "Alternative Logging Program - No open-hole logs were run" and shall clearly identify the type of log and the well (by API#) in which open-hole logs were run.
