Operator must update Principal Agent designation

Pursuant to Rule 302.b., Operator shall submit a Designation of Agent ("Form 1A") listing employees approved to submit documents to COGCC on behalf of the Operator. The Form 1A requires identification of a Principal Agent designated to accept and be served notices from COGCC. Operator shall immediately report all changes to reported agent information by submitting a new Form 1A.

If Operator does not have a Principal Agent designated in the COGIS database, or if there have been changes to the Principal Agent designation or contact information, please report the current information on a **new Form 1A no later than:**

January 31, 2020.
