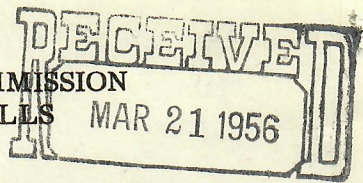

The elevation above sea level is 4837.2 Ft.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands. Show sizes, weights, and length of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

It is planned to drill an oil and gas test well with rotary tools deep enough to thoroughly test both the "D" and "J" sand formation with a total depth at approximately 5100 feet. Approximately 120 feet of 8 5/8" surface casing cemented with approximately 120 sacks of cement will be set. Should production be encountered 5 1/2" casing will be set through the producing formation and cemented at that point. Top of the "D" sand formation is expected to be encountered at about 4990 and the top of the "J" sand formation at approximately 5050.
