Mr. Mouret,

Attached please find an inspection done on January 17 in response to a complaint (#200448545) in reference to possible spill/releases at the central tank battery at the Nile Filed enhanced recovery project in the SESE of section 18 – 1 South – 60 west in Adams County Colorado.

Our electronic notice system listed you as undeliverable for these documents.

Also back in May of 2019 PPP submitted a spill/release notice (Form 19) for a release at the Nile Field tank battery. That Form 19 was an initial and by COGCC rules requires a follow-up (form 19 submittal). By rule 906.b.(4) requires an additional reporting with a supplemental form 19 filed no later than 10 calendar days prior to the initial notice. To date no follow-on information (including an supplemental form (19) on this release. Please submit a supplemental for the 2019 spill and an additional information in support to a closure for the 2019 release.

- (4) In addition to the Initial Report to the Director, the Operator shall make a supplemental report on Form 19 not more than 10 calendar days after the spill/release is discovered that includes an 8 1/2 x 11 inch topographic map showing the governmental section and location of the spill or an aerial photograph showing the location of the spill; all pertinent information about the spill/release known to the Operator that has not been reported previously; and information relating to the initial mitigation, site investigation, and remediation measures conducted by the Operator.
