At approximately 5:45 AM on February 8, 2020 a contractor was pumping methanol into a separator to clear a line freeze. He then slightly opened the blowdown valve to clear the freeze into a drain bucket. This released a small amount of hydrocarbon liquids and gas. Despite company policy which requires all ignition sources to be shut off, the separator burner had not been shut off. The valve was immediately closed, however a small fire resulted which was put out with a fire extinguisher. A safety stand down was initiated to review procedures. The individual who disregarded company policy was removed from location and appropriately disciplined.
