- (4) It is further understood and agreed that all depth measurements shall be supervised by the customer or its employees, and customer hereby certifies that the zones, as shot were in proper condition for the performance of said work.
- (5) The customer certifies that it has the full right and authority to order such work on such well and that the well in which the work is to be done by Mercury W L is in proper and suitable condition for the performance of said work.
- (6) No employee is authorized to alter the terms or conditions of this agreement.
