Comment: It was documented in this inspection that the cut slopes on the east end of the Location are exposed and at risk of erosion degradation. See photo 5.

It was also observed that stormwater runoff from the Location is causing erosion degradation (gully) on the slope of the east end of the Location. See photos 6-8

Corrective Action: Install or repair required BMPs per Rule 1002.f.(2)C and in accordance with good engineering practices; ensure BMPs are maintained in proper functioning condition to stabilize soils and to allow for proper sediment laden-free stormwater discharge from the Location; Continue to conduct stormwater management in accordance with Rule 1002.f until location receives a passing final reclamation inspection.
