Good Afternoon Mr. Verbonitz,

My initial inspection in January was a result of me being new to the area (took over a portion of the NW region from Lou in December) and that this well was on my high priority list for inspections. As I was unable to personally get a good look of the location due to snow cover in January, I needed to do a follow up once conditions had improved. I found myself in the area of the Location this week, and with clear conditions I was able to more accurately assess the Location. According to well file records, the last inspection on this Location was conducted 7/22/2019 and submitted 9/21/2019. I am unsure as to why the report was submitted almost 3 months later but I will do my best to ensure my inspection reports are submitted to Bayswater in a timely manner.

I have no doubt that Bayswater will conduct the work by the corrective action date and I look forward to seeing the Location return to compliance. Please submit a resolution form with documentation once the work has been completed.
