Photo 1. View of the eastern edge of the well pad facing southward. Vegetation (alfalfa) in left portion of the photo is off of the project area, vegetation (alfalfa) in the right of the photo is within the project area. Alfalfa within the project area is significantly more stunted, sparse, and weedy than the alfalfa outside of the project area.



Photo 2. Closeup of vegetation at the edge of the project area showing well-established alfalfa on left and stunted vegetation on the right.



Photo 3. View of representative quadrat vegetation within the project area. Alfalfa is approximately 4 inches tall and sparse.
