Messrs. McNair and Roethel,

After consulting with management staff of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC"), COGCC does not support the Greenleaf Environmental Services LLC ("Greenleaf") request (Sundry Notice Document # 402181482, September 19, 2019) for a Rule 502.b Variance for relief from the Rule 713 requirement for financial assurance in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the Class II commercial Underground Injection Control Greenleaf Disposal #1 well. The request provided a trust fund account in addition to a Certificate of Liability Insurance which the COGCC does not recognize as means for establishing financial assurance. Additionally, it was stated that... "an extra-large spill that caused Greenleaf to file bankruptcy would be cleaned up using financial assurance." By Greenleaf using the trust fund account to address the extra-large spill, it is likely that there may not be additional funds remaining to cover the decommissioning of surface facilities and structures appurtenant to the Class II Commercial Underground Injection Control (UIC) well, remediation, and reclamation of those area(s), and the area in and around the wellhead.

Greenleaf should contact Ms. Deborah Lutz (Financial Assurance Supervisor, 303-894-2100 x 5185, [Debbie.lutz@state.co.us](mailto:Debbie.lutz@state.co.us)) regarding the process to comply with Rule 713.

If Greenleaf Environmental chooses to do so they may request a hearing before the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. This application should be made through the Commission's Hearings Group. (Mimi Larsen, 303-894-2100 x5152, [mimi.larsen@state.co.us](mailto:mimi.larsen@state.co.us))
