To whom this may concern,

This is a description of the work Ridgeline Seeding & Reclamation, Inc. will be doing to manage, mitigate and control jointed goat grass on the location cut and fill slope.

Ridgeline's plan of action is to install silt fence around the bottom of the location (approximately 350 ft) to prevent the jointed goat grass from continuing to spread off site.

The silt fence will also prevent all future storm water and silt runoff from leaving the site while the project is under the revegetation process.

Ridgeline recommends revegetating this site in stages (up to 10-15 ft wide by the length of the location at a time) in order to control erosion and keep noxious weeds to a minimum. This process will be a multi season program that consists of regular maintenance and site inspections.

The revegetation process is to treat the jointed goat grass then, when the timing is sufficient, we will rip, cultivate, seed, straw mulch and crimp certified weed free straw on all disturbed areas.

The seed mix will be a native mix that matches the surrounding vegetation and anything hand broadcasted will be at double the seed rate.

Please take into consideration that the existing jointed goat grass is coming in right now and is best treated when it is premature so that we do not fight the process of it going to seed and causing more work.
