## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

A partially buried 40 bbl produced water tank was removed during P&A activities. Following removal of the water tank, LT Environmental conducted confirmation soil sampling of the tank grave on May 28, 2020. Each side wall of the tank grave was field screened for potential petroleum hydrocarbon impact such as staining and/or odor and VOC concentrations were measured using a PID detector. No field evidence of petroleum hydrocarbon impact was observed. One grab soil sample was collected from the west sidewall (SS01@5') which exhibited the highest VOC concentration observed of 1.45 ppm. Additionally, one grab soil sample (SS02@6') was collected from the floor of the tank grave. Groundwater was not observed in the open tank grave. Samples were collected per USEPA methods and strict chain-of-custody standards were followed. The soil samples were submitted to Summit Scientific for laboratory analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylene (BTEX), and total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH)-gasoline range organic (GRO) by USEPA 8260C, TPH-diesel range organics (DRO) by USEPA Method 8015C. The floor soil sample was also submitted for analysis of pH by USEPA Method 9045D, specific conductance (EC) by USEPA Method 9050A, and sodium adsorption ration (SAR) by USDA Agricultural Handbook 60 method (20B).

Soil sample SS02@6' exceeded the COGCC Table 910-1 standard for pH with a detected value of 9.21. All other laboratory analytical results were compliant with COGCC Table 910-1 concentration levels.
