This email is to address a COA on Initial Form 19 #401386713 for spill #452037 on the Cascade Creek 620-24-43 pad, dated 08/23/17.

Fluids were originally noted on the pad surface and appeared to be coming from an underground dump line. They line was isolated to prevent further possible contamination. Excavation of the area determined a dump line was leaking due to corrosion. The damaged portion of the line was removed and replaced with Flexpipe.

Attached are annual dump line pressure tests for the 620-24-43 pad for 2017, 2018 and 2019.
